Lieutenant Governor Brad Little today announced his candidacy for the Republican nomination for the office of Lieutenant Governor today.

Little made a series of stops for the official announcement around the state including Boise, Idaho Falls and Coeur d'Alene.

At all three campaign appearances Little was introduced by one or more of his campaign co-chairmen all of whom preceded him in the office of Lieutenant Governor; including Governor C.L. "Butch" Otter, who introduced him in Boise .

Little commented, "I am delighted today to announce my candidacy for the office of Lt. Governor. Idaho needs leaders who continue to champion conservative values that protect and enhance our way of life. With this campaign it is my intention to promote statewide economic expansion as well as the messages of personal responsibility and accountability that are the bedrock values of our great state."

Brad Little was appointed lieutenant governor in January of 2009 after serving as Majority Caucus Chairman in the Idaho State Senate. He is a rancher from Emmett.

Lt. Governor Little also serves as chairman of the Governor's Transportation Task Force, which has been tasked with finding long-term solutions to funding Idaho's \$16 billion dollar state infrastructure.
